Pat Robertson vs. The Craft

FOR DECADES, Pat Robertson has been well-known as an evangelist, media tycoon, and occasional presidential candidate. He is also a staunch anti-Mason who never allows facts to get in the way of his opinions.

In his book *The New World Order*, Robertson repeats a series of old and disproven accusations, e.g., that Freemasons conspired with the Illuminati, a European secret society, to instigate the French and Russian Revolutions, that our rituals are neither Biblical nor Christian, that we worship a pagan god, that we promote world revolution in order to gain power and influence, and the list goes on.

Robertson's incomprehension of Freemasonry is evidenced by this absurd statement in a chapter of his book, "New Order for the New Age" page 185: "As part of the initiation for the thirty-second degree, the candidate is told that Hiram, the builder of Solomon's Temple, was killed by three assassins. The candidate, therefore, must strike back against these assassins which are the government, organized religion, and private property."

How shall Masons respond to this kind of nonsense? We can simply ignore it, which has been a long-standing policy, or we can expose it for the bias and ignorance that it represents. Today's Masonic leaders, let us hope, will choose the latter. -JS
