OUR BRETHREN IN NORTH CAROLINA are taking an innovative approach to educating the Craft's future leaders.

The Grand Lodge, in cooperation with the Scottish Rite, created Wilkerson College, named for a retired Marine Corps General and 33rd Degree Mason. Its purpose is to provide North Carolina Freemasonry with well-trained, forward-looking officers. Fifty Masons comprise each class, nearly all of them deacons. Five hundred have graduated thus far, and all are making a positive impact.

The curriculum includes topics such as the origins and traditions of Masonry, lodge budgeting, member services, and community relations. Instructors are all high-ranking Masons, experts in their fields, and respected mentors.

This program, according to the Grand Lodge, brings the student from the level of merely "filling a chair" to the point where he brings a newfound commitment to the betterment of his lodge and community. Δ
